The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the Feb. 12th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Londot reported that on this same evening Mr. Don Logdson reported to him that the south side of the first bridge on Twp. 214 east of Co. 204 had fallen from the bridge. This was to be inspected by Mr. Londot and Mr. Hull and a telephone report made to the County Engineer.

Mr. Hull reported that the bridge on Twp. 251 east of Co. 204 needed some new plank. This was also to be reported to the County Engineer.

The clerk was instructed to write a letter to the County Engineer advising of the condition of the above two bridges.

Mr. Gene Richards was appointed Fire Prevention Officer for Washington Township.

The president declared the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and checks have been issued in payment of same.
