The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

The minutes of the March 22nd meeting were read and approved.

The meeting time of the Board was changed from 7:30 PM to 8:00 PM beginning April 19th and continuing through the period of daylight savings time.

Mr. Wince moved that Mr. John Ross be appointed Zoning Inspector of Washington Township and that the salary be set at twenty five dollars (\$25.00) per month beginning with the month of April 1971 and continuing through the year of 1971.
