The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hall.

Also present, from Newark Township, were: Mr. Stickle, Mr. Harvey and Mr. Pound.

The minutes of the April 5th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Stickle, trustee of Newark Township, presented to the Board an explanation and the provisions of the Emergency Squad Service that could be furnished by The Volunteer Fire Department of Newark Township. After much discussion and various questions clarified and answered, Board action was as follows:

Mr. Wince offered the following resolution and moved it's adoption:

Whereas, there existed in Washington Township a need for emergency service in emergency situations,

and whereas, the Board of Trustees of Washington Township desires to provide this service to the Township,

Now Therefore, be it resolved that Washington Township enter into an agreement with Newark Township to provide this service at a cost of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each and every run into Washington Township.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the roll call vote was as follows:

Mr. Torrens- Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the resolution adopted.

The agreement was executed and signed by the presidents of both Boards and the clerks of both Boards.

The original copy of the above agreement is on file in Township records.

The clerk was instructed to order from the Utica Insurance Agency a Bond in the amount of one thousand dollars for the Township Zoning Inspector, Mr. John Ross.

The president declared the motion approved.
