The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the May 3rd. meeting were read and approved.

The Washington Township Zoning Commission had received application from Heinrich Fischer, Rt. 1, St. Louisville, Ohio for rezoning of part of his property and a hearing was to be held May 26th, 1971. Board members expressed interest in attending this hearing.

A fire report was received from the Township Fire Prevention Office and was received, noted and filed.

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Due to have been appointed Zoning Inspector, the Board accepted the resignation of John W. Ross from the Twp. Zoning Commission.

Charles Johnson, Rt. 1, St. Louisville, Ohio was appointed as a member of the Township Zoning Commission to fill the term of John Ross, resigned.

A report was received from the Licking County Common Pleas Court concerning two recent line fence court cases. This report indicated that Trustees should very carefully consider the overall benefit to land owners before making a decision on line fence disputes.

After inspecting Township road weed conditions, the Board decided that as of this date there would be no need to spray.
