The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were; Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the May 17th meeting were read and approved.

The Township records were audited and inspected in 1970 and the charge for this service was indicated to be \$288.00. The appropriation for 1971 to cover this expenditure was \$300.00. The deduction by the County Auditor based on figures furnished by the Bureau of Inspection was \$320.00.

In order to cover this expenditure, Mr. Wince moved that the sum of \$20.00 be transferred from Gen. Fund. 1A26 to Gen. Fund 1A19.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.


Mr. Londot moved that the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the Township in payment of same.

I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to ~~pay~~ pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.


