June 14, 1971

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The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull. Mr. Wince was absent. The minutes of the May 31st meeting were read and approved.

The Clerk received from Joe Stevenson, secretary of the Zoning Commission, a copy of the minutes of a meeting of the Zoning Commission, delivered personally June 14th, 1971 at about 8:00 PM. The Zoning Commission recommended that an application by Heinrich Fischer for District Change of approximately 1.2 acres of his property be changed from Agricultural to General Business District, be allowed for use of an upholstery shop.

Mr. Londot moved that The Township Trustees hold a Hearing on this same application and that the Clerk place a Public Hearing Notice to appear in the Utica Herald June 24, 1971 stating that the Hearing would be held July 9, 1971, 8:00 PM in the City Building at Utica, Ohio and that the Clerk ~~xxxxxx~~ notify by certified mail those property owners as listed on the application.

Mr. Torrens seconded the motion.

Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes. The president declared motion approved.

The charge for the 1970 State Examination of Township Records had been indicated to be \$288.00. The deduction by the County Auditor was \$320.00. The clerk was instructed to write the Bureau requesting information on this difference.

The 1972 Budget Forms had been received from the County Auditor and the Trustees indicated that preparation of the Budget should be started at the next meeting.
