The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens-Mr. Wince-Mr. Londot-Mr. Kinney-Mr. Hull
Mr. John Weaver and Mr. Guy Weaver.

The minutes of the Nov. 1st. meeting were read and approved.

Mr. George F. Wince presented a Sheep Claim and his witnesses were Mr. John Weaver and Mr. Guy Weaver. Proper forms were completed and handed to Mr. Wince for presentation the the Board of County Commissioners.

The membership terms of Dale Stradley of the Township Zoning Commission and J.J. Wahl of the Township Board of Zoning Appeals were due to expire on Nov. 17, 1971.

Mr. Londot moved that Mr. Dale Stradley be reappointed for a term of five years to the Township Zoning Commission and that, Mr. J.J. Wahl be reappointed ~~to~~ for a term of five years to the Township Board of Zoning Appeals.
