The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. James W. Torrens; Mr. George F. Wince; Mr. Jack T. Londot; Mr. John E. Kinney and Mr. Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the Jan 1st. meeting were read and approved.

A report was received from the Utica Volunteer Fire Dept. indicating that they had made twelve runs into Washington Township in 1971.

Motion was made by Mr. Wince and seconded by Mr. Londot that Washington Township enter into an agreement with Newark Township, Licking County, Ohio whereby Newark Township will provide emergence squad service to Washington Township at a cost of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each and every run into Washington Township and, that Washington Township shall not be liable for any loss occasioned to or by the emergency vehicle being used.

Roll call Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the resolution duly adopted.

(One copy completed and furnished Newark Twp and one copy on file.)

Mr. Wince moved that Myers W. Hull be hired as road superintendent of Washington Township for the year 1972 at a rate of pay of three dollars and sixty nine cents (\$3.69) per hour and that he also be allowed vacation pay of two hundred eighty dollars (\$280.00) payable after July 1, 1972; and that, other hired labor for the Township be paid at a rate of two dollars and sixty three cents (\$2.63) per hour.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.

Roll call: Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.; Mr. Torrens abstained.

Mr. Londot moved that: Each trustee be given authority to take care of an emergency as deemed necessary by each Trustee and that each Trustee be allowed to instruct the Road Superintendent in handling the emergency.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Roll call Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr.Londot-Yes.

The president declared the motion approved.

Motio, was made by Mr. Wince and seconded by Mr. Londot that: The necessary expenses incurred by Township Officials while in attendance at Association Meetings Meetings and in the performance of Official business be allowed at cost and, that mileage be allowed at ten cents per mile and garage at cost.

Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the motion approved.

An inventory of Township equipment and supplies as listed by the clerk was approved and placed in the minute book

Letter of resignation effective Jan.10,1972 was received from Gene Richards, Township Fire Prevention Officer was received and accepted on motion by Mr. Torrens and seconded by Mr. Londot.
