The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull, also present were Mr. John Weaver and Mr. Guy Weaver.

The minutes of the April 3rd meeting were read and approved.

The Board discussed the removal of trees on Twp Rd. 214 and decided that they would take a look at same and do what had to be done.

Mr. Torrens reported that he had again contacted the County engineering Dept. concerning the installation of a culvert on Twp Rd. 214. The need for this culvert had been requested in writing in February 1971.

The accumulation of trash along roads had again reached a point that ~~necessitated~~ made clean-up necessary. Mr. Londot volunteered to contact an Ecology class in the local school to see whether or not they would be interested in picking up this trash and at what cost.

The question of whether or not Zoning in Washington Township be repealed would appear on the ballot at the May 2, 1972 election. The Board expressed their hope that zoning would be retained and that effort would be made toward this.

Mr. George F. Wince presented a sheep claim and his witnesses were John Weaver and Guy Weaver. Necessary papers were completed and handed to Mr. Wince for further disposition.
