The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.
Also present were: Mr. Joe Torrens; Mr. Joe Stevenson; Mr. Paul Torrens; Mr. R.E. Sensibaugh; Mr. R.L. Sensibaugh; Mr. John Weaver; Mr. Guy Weaver.
The minutes of the May 1st. meeting were read and approved.

The following sheep claims were prepared:

Mr. Joe Torrens: His witnesses were: Joe Stevenson and Paul Torrens.

Mr. George Wince: His witnesses were: John Weaver and Guy Weaver.

Mr. James Torrens: His witnesses were: R.E. Sensibaugh and R.L. Sensibaugh.

Forms were completed and presented to claimants for further handling.

Notice was received from the Licking County Board of Elections stating that the ZONING REPEAL in Washington Township was defeated by a vote of 99- Yes and 125-No.

Next regular meeting date being on a holiday, the date was changed to May 31 and the meeting time for the summer months was changed to 8:00 PM.

The Board had investigated the culvert situation on Twp. 205 south of CH 200 and decided that a new culvert and ditching was required.

The Board expressed appreciation that the County had installed a new large culvert, replacing a narrow and dangerous bridge, on Twp 214.
