The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Marvin Snyder.

The minutes of the May 15th meeting were read and approved.

Notice was received from the Licking County Regional Planning Commission that the membership fee for the year 1973 for Washington Township was tentatively set at eighty three dollars (\$83.00).

Mr. Snyder, a weed and brush spray contractor, explained his service to the Board. After considerably discussion, the Board agreed to check conditions along highways on June 2nd and advise Mr. Snyder of spray application needed.
