The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present Were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.
Mr. Wince was absent.

The minutes of the May 31st meeting were read and approved.

The Fire Contract with The Utica Volunteer Fire Department is due to expire on July 1, 1972. The clerk was instructed to procure a one year contract from the Fire Department and have available for the June 26th meeting in order that the contract could be considered when all members would probably be present.

The 1973 Township Budget was discussed by the Trustees to the extent that it could be prepared at the next meeting. The clerk stated that he would have the preliminary work finished and ready at the next meeting.

The Road Superintendent was instructed as to what portions of what roads were to receive weed and brush spray. Same to be applied by Marvin Snyder.

Mr. Londot reported that the 8th Grade Ecology class had completed the trash pick-up along Township Roads and that payment was in order.
