The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the June 26th meeting were read and approved.

The Budget had been prepared and the Budget Hearing had been advertised to be July 10th 1972. There was no public attendance for the hearing.

Mr. Londot moved that the Washington Township Budget for the year 1973 be approved as prepared and forwarded to the County Auditor.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

The president declared the motion approved.

Repairs to Twp. Rd. ³⁷25 Northwest of Utica was discussed. Definite decision was not made pending consulting with an engineer for assistance.

A phone call was received from the Sheriff's office reporting that a tree was down on Twp Rd. 207 one half mile west of ^{1st}206. Mr. Hull was instructed to investigate and proceed with removal.
