The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the July 24th meeting were read and approved.

The recent application of weed killer on roadsides was discussed and it was the opinion of the Board that the effectiveness was generally very good. However, it was agreed that in the coming year certain areas should be treated earlier due to crops being grown in adjacent locations.

The grading and ditching of roads, which is a continuing operation, ~~was~~ had been temporarily halted due to the grader being down for repair. Now that the unit was back in operation, the Board discussed with the Road Superintendent the roads which should have priority in conditioning.
