The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the August 7th meeting were read and approved.

The next regular meeting date being Sept. 4th and also Labor Day holiday, Mr. Wince moved that this meeting be re-scheduled to Monday Sept. 11th at the regular time.

The Board had received from The Licking County Regional Planning Commission a proposed fee schedule which would up-date, ~~the~~ and increase some fees, for the various applications and permits as related to Zoning in Washington Township.
