The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the August 21st meeting were read and approved.

This meeting had been rescheduled from Sept. 4th.

An invoice had been received from Cummins Diesel Central Ohio Inc. for repairs recently made on the grader engine in amount of 1075.71 with credit for parts and tax of 728.24 leaving a balance of 347.47. Payment of this bill was delayed pending a check of the repairs by King Equipment Co. from whom the grader was purchased.

Zoning in Washington Township was widely discussed with the opinion being that it was working satisfactorily with the exception of Mobil and/or Trailer Homes. Applicants for permits seemed to be uninformed, misinformed or confused as to the Temporary, Conditional and other uses of Mobil Homes as allowed by the Zoning Resolution by action of the Board of Zoning Appeals. The solution of this matter was not determined at this meeting.
