The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. James W. Torrens; Mr. George F. Wince; Mr. Jack T. Londot; Mr. John E. Kinney and Mr. Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the September 18th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Londot moved that the following transfer of funds be made:
From MVL 2B2 Materials to MVL 2B3 Contracts the sum of \$700.00
From R&B 4B2 Materials to R&B 4B3 Contracts the sum of \$800.00

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the motion carried.

Copies of minutes of Public Hearings held by The Board of Zoning Appeals was received, noted and filed.

Rates as established by P.E.R.S. Beginning Jan 1, 1973, was received, noted and filed.
Rates to be: Employee - 8.1 % and Employer - 9.4%.

The resignation of Myers W. Hull as member of the Washington Township Board of Zoning Appeals was received.

Mr. Wince moved that Mr. Hull be thanked for his services and that the resignation be accepted.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.

The vote was all in favor and the president declared the motion approved.

Mr. Torrens had contacted the King Equipment Co. concerning the repairs to the grader engine by The Cummins Diesel Co. protesting the charges for the repair. A copy of a letter from King Equipment to Cummins Diesel and a copy of a letter from Cummins Diesel to King Equipment had been received.

Cummins Diesel indicated that the charges made by them was in accordance with company policy and further credit was not issued.

The Board did not authorize payment at this time pending further attempts for additional consideration.
