The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. James W. Torrens; Mr. George F. Wince; Mr. Jack T. Londot; Mr. John E. Kinney and Mr. Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the October 2nd meeting were read and approved.

The Depository Contract with the First National Bank due to expire on Nov. 17, 1972, the Clerk was instructed to contact the Bank toward having a new contract ready for approval prior to date of expiration.

The Grader engine repair job was again discussed with Mr. Torrens reporting that he had talked with The King Equipment Co. and having been advised that further credit could be forthcoming, the Clerk was instructed to write to King Equipment Co. and to Cummins Diesel Central Ohio Inc. requesting that the matter be finalized prior to the end of the month.
