The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot; John E. Kinney; Myers W. Hull; Robert Bickle and Dean Harris.

The minutes of the March 5th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Bickle represented The American Culvert Co. and informed the Board that he could furnish culvert pipe in various sizes and at competitive prices.

Mr. Harris informed the Board that he had decided not to build a house in Washington Township.

Permit applications for crossing Township roads at three different points had been received from Columbia Gas Transmission Co. These items were tabled pending further information.

The planned use of 1972 Federal Revenue Sharing money was widely discussed by the Board with definite decisions being postponed until some future meeting.
