The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot; John E. Kinney; Myers W. Hull; Dale Stradley; Tom Hurst; Robert Farson; C.F. Smith; and Marvin Snyder.

The minutes of the April 16th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Dale Stradley presented a claim for sheep killed by dogs. His witnesses were Tom Hurst and Robert Farson. The claim was prepared by the Board and handed to Mr. Stradley for further disposition.

Mr. C.F. Smith, representing the local Emergency Unit, informed the Board that the State Dept. of Transportation was disposing of obsolete radio equipment and requested that the Board, as a Political Subdivision, ~~to~~ inquire into the possibility of acquiring some of this equipment for the Emergency Unit. On motion by Mr. Londot and second by Mr. Wince, the Clerk was directed to write to the Dept. of Transportation requesting information as to the availability, procedure to obtain and cost of the radio equipment.

The Clerk had received from The Office of Revenue Sharing forms for filing Planned Use Report of expending funds for the Period Jan. 1, 1973 to Jun. 30, 1973. The Board studied this report and discussed possibilities of expenditure. Final plans for expenditure were not made at this time.
