The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot; John E. Kinney; Myers W. Hull; and Mr. Reno Mohn.

The minutes of the April 30th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Mohn represented The Buckeye Culvert Co. and indicated to the Board that there was a very good possibility of a price increase in the near future and that his Company would be glad to supply any need for culvert for the Township. No purchase was made at this meeting.

On motion by Mr. Wince and second by Mr. Londot, John E. Kinney was appointed Assistant Zoning Inspector for the Township due to John W. Ross being hospitalized. Mr. Kinney accepted the appointment to run for a short period of time at no pay.

The next regular meeting being on a holiday, the meeting was rescheduled for Thursday May 31, 1973.
