The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot; John E. Kinney and Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the June 11th meeting were read and approved.

The Fire Contract with The Utica Volunteer Fire Dept. had been received from the Fire Dept. for a one year period beginning June 30, 1973 and ending ~~December 31st~~ June 30, 1974 at an annual cost of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500.00) with payment of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) to be made in advance each six months.

Mr. George F. Wince moved that this contract be approved and accepted and that payment be made for the first six months of the contract.
