The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot; John E. Kinney and Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the July 23rd meeting were read and approved.

Resignation was received from Stuart Bovard, resigning from the Township Zoning Commission. Mr. Wince moved that it be accepted. Mr.Londot seconded the motion. Vote was all in favor. Motion declared approved.

Mr. Londot moved that Stuart Bovard be appointed as a member of the Township Board of Zoning Appeals. Mr. Wince seconded the motion. Vote was all in favor. Motion was declared approved.

An updated Fee Schedule for Zoning was widely discussed by the Board with a tentative schedule worked out. The Clerk was instructed to prepare the new schedule for the next meeting for further consideration.

In order to cover all charges to Appropriation 1A3 Mr. Londot moved that the amount of \$32.96 be transferred from Gen. Fund 1C5 to Gen Fund 1A3.

Mr. Wince mm seconded the motion. Vote was all in favor. Motion approved.

At a Public Hearing held by the Washington Township Zoning Commission on July 30 1973, an Amendment to Article 8.2, Conditional Use in the AG District, was added as subparagraph 5 as follows:

"5. Barber Shops, Beauty Parlors, Grooming of Household Pets and Other Similar uses within a dwelling by the occupant of the dwelling and as a secondary use which is clearly incidental to the use of the dwelling for residential purposes. Such use shall employ not more than one person outside the family residence t of the dwelling and such use shall not change the character of the dwelling."

In accordance with the Washington Township Zoning Resolution, Mr. George F. Wince moved that the Washington Township Board of Trustees hold a Public Hearing on the above Amendment in the Township Office on August 29th, 1973 at 8:00 P.M. Mr. Jawk T. Londot seconded the motion.

Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes. Resolution adopted.
