The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in Special Session this date for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing on an Amendment to the Township Zoning Resolution.

Trustees Present: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince and Jack T. Londot.
Clerk present.... John E. Kinney
Others present... Robert M. Orr and Myers W. Hull.

President Torrens opened the Public Hearing stating that the Washington Township Zoning Commission at a Public Hearing held July 30, 1973 had approved an amendment to Article 8.2, Conditional Uses in the AG District adding subparagraph 5 (page 19) as follows:

"5. Barber shops, beauty parlors, the grooming of household pets, and other similar uses within a dwelling by the occupant of the dwelling and as a secondary use which is clearly incidental to the use of the dwelling for residential purposes. Such use shall employ not more than one person outside the family resident of the dwelling and such use shall not change the character of the dwelling. "

and that, this amendment be recommended to the Washington Township Board of Trustees.

No one appeared at the hearing to oppose the amendment.

Mr. George F. Wince moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

Be It Resolved by the Board of Trustees of Washington Township, Licking County, Ohio, that an Amendment be added to Article 8.2, Conditional Uses in the AG DISTRICT adding subparagraph 5 (page 19) as follows:

" 5. Barber shops, beauty parlors, the grooming of household pets, and other similar uses within a dwelling by the occupant of the dwelling and as a secondary use which is clearly incidental to the use of the dwelling for residential purposes. Such use shall employ not more than one person outside the family resident of the dwelling and such use shall not change the character of the dwelling. "

and that, this amendment be the same as that which was recommended by the Washington Township Zoning Commission and that, this Amendment be made a part of the Washington Township Zoning Resolution.

Mr. Jack T. Londot seconded the Resolution and the roll being called on its adoption the vote resulted as follows:
