The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince & Jack T. Londot  
Clerk: John E. Kinney & Road Supt.: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the February 18th meeting were read and approved.

The clerk reported that the Certificates of Deposit, representing Federal Revenue Sharing Funds, had been renewed as of March 1st for a period of sixty days.

Mr. Londot reported that No. 67 Limestone would cost \$3.40 per ton delivered to the Township lot.

Resolution accepting the Amounts and Rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor.
