The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present\*Trustees- James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot. Clerk-John E. Kinney & Road Supt.-Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the June 3rd meeting were read and approved.

A Certificate of Deposit in amount of \$4146.00 representing Federal Revenue Sharing funds is due to expire on June 14th. Mr. Wince moved that this Certificate be cashed in and redeposited in the checking account in order to have sufficient funds to pay for the new truck which would be due and payable at the next meeting. Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote was all in favor of the motion.

Mr. Londot stated that there seemed to be some confusion as to the zoning in the Township. The Board agreed that there should be signs posted at all entrances to the Township indicating that the Township was zoned.
