The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were- Trustees: James W. Torrens and Jack T. Londot.
 Clerk: John E. Kinney and Road Supt.: Myers W. Hull
 Zoning Insptr: James L. Dickson.

Absent----- Trustee: George F. Wince

The minutes of the July 8th meeting were read and approved.

The clerk had received from the Licking County Sheriff copies of Amended House Bill 650 and Sub.H.H. 635 pertaining to junk yards and abonded motor vehicles. These copies were dsitributed to each Trustee.

A letter was received from John G. Carlisle with an invoice for a PTO shaft and requesting that he be allowed to pick up the snow plow which was traded in on a new plow on order of May 13, 74. A letter in reply to Mr. Carlisle was written questioning the Boards obligation to pay for the PTO shaft and indicating that the new plow should be delivered prior to surrendering the trade-in. A copy of this letter is attached to the minute record.

Mr. Dickson presented information imdicating that there was some interest by Township residents in operating small family shops such as welding and repair. There being no provision in the Zoning Resolution to allow a business of this type, Mr. Dickson suggested that the matter be taken before the Zoning Commission for consideration. Since no application for an amendment was presented, Mr. Torrens said he would contact the Chairman of the Zoning Commission and that possibly the Commission would hold an informal meeting to discuss the matter.

Dear Mr. Carlisle:

In regard to your letter of July 20, 1974, which was discussed at our meeting to-night (July 20~~2~~), we decided that since Gledhill did not honor our order before the 8% raise in price and that, we did not get the old PTO shaft off the old truck back when we purchased the old spreader, we should not be obligated to pay for a new PTO shaft. This should be for you and Gledhill to work out.

In reference to your picking up the old snow plow, we believe that we should have the new plow mounted on our new truck before the trade-in plow is picked up.
