The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.
 Present were: Trustees-James W. Torrens, George F. Wince & Jack T Londot.

 The minutes of the July 22nd meeting were read and approved.

Notice was received from the County Auditor that the Licking County Budget Commission would hold hearings on the budgets for 1975. The clerk was instructed to notify the Commission and request date and time for appearance.

The clerk advised the Board that the typing table presently being used was too small, too unstable and very unsuitable for the job. The Board checked the table and Mr. Wince moved that the clerk purchase a typing table suitable for office use. Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote was as follows:
