The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township. Present were: Trustees: James W. Torrens; George F. Wince; Jack T. Londot
Clerk: John E. Kinney & Road Supt: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the April 14th meeting were read and approved. Mr. Kinney reported that he had received a refund check in amount of \$45.00 from the Lone Star Insurance Co. due to his application for cancer insurance being denied due to his being overage. Said check would be deposited to the account of the Township.

Notice was received from the Licking County Commissioners that the annexation hearing on application by F. Richard Heath, agent for David L. Hite, would be held June 23, 1975 at 10:00 AM.

Stuart Bovard, a member of the Township Board of Zoning Appeals, had moved from the Township and was removed from the above Board. Lawrence A. Brandt, Rt. 2, Utica was appointed to replace Mr. Bovard and the clerk was requested to so advise Mr. Brandt, by letter.

On April 21st The United Telephone Co. contacted Mr. Torrens to obtain permission to bury phone line on the north side of Twp. Rd. 207. Said line to begin approx 300ft/east of SR 13 and continue ~~for~~ for 5800 ft. Mr. Torrens contacted Mr. Wince on the matter and the two Trustees approved the application for permission and Mr. Torrens signed the application for approval.

Over the past several weeks there had been window breakage at the Township garage and some items which were stored in the open were missing. Due to this, Mr. Londot submitted the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"Due to recent vandalism at the Washington Township property located between State Route 13 and old Blacksnake Road, any unauthorized persons caught trespassing will be prosecuted. The Utica Police Department has been notified of the window breakage and other damage." and Mr. Londot further moved that the above be published as a PUBLIC NOTICE in the local newspaper".

Mr. Wince seconded the resolution and the vote resulted as follows: Mr. Torrens-Yea; Mr. Wince-Yea; Mr. Londot-Yea.

Resolution adopted.

Mr. Hull was instructed to obtain four "No Trespassing" signs and install them on the perimeter of the Township lot.
