The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were-Trustees: James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.
 Clerk: John E. Kinney & Road Supt: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the August 18th meeting were read and approved.

Application forms for PERS .4% deduction refund were distributed to all persons who received salaries or wages for the period Jan. 1, 1973 to June 30, 1973.

Request for locations for all railroad crossings in the Township was received from the Ohio Department of Transportation. ~~It was~~ The clerk was instructed to ^{advise} ODOT of the only crossing which is located on TR 207 one and one half miles east of State Route 13.

Patch and pave estimate information had been received from the Newark Asphalt Co. No action was taken by the Board at this time.

Mr. Londot moved that there be transferred from Gas Tax Fund 3A4 to Gas Tax Fund 3B2 the amount of \$1500.00. Mr. Wince seconded the motion and the vote was: Mr. Torrens-Yea; Mr. Wince-Yea; Mr. Londot-Yea. The president declared the motion approved.
