The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees-James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot. Clerk-John E. Kinney; Road Supt-Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the Sept. 29th meeting were read and approved.

In order that the Road & Bridge appropriation for Misc. Supplies be sufficient to cover expenditures as anticipated, Mr. Wince moved that the following transfer be made:

Road & Bridge Fund- From 4A10	to 4A5	100.00	
	From 4B2	to 4A5	88.60 188.60

Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote was follows:

Mr. Torrens-Yea; Mr. Wince-Yea; Mr. Londot-Yea.

The president declared the motion approved.

Mr. Harper Donald, land owner on the south side of Twp. Rd. 75A (dead end road to COAD Cemetery) had contacted the Trustees for assistance in locating fence line on the south side of the above mentioned road. Having met with Mr. Donald at the location and discussed the matter with him on a previous date,

Mr. Londot moved that the Board of Trustees approve a fence line running parallel to and not less than twenty two feet (22ft) from the existing fence along the north side of Twp. Rd. 75A.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion and the vote resulted as follows:
