The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees-George F. Wince, James W. Torrens, J. T. Londot.
Clerk-John E. Kinney & Road Supt-Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the January 19th meeting were read and approved.

A letter from Dr. Paul W. Thonas, Supt. of North Fork Local School District, expressing appreciation and commendation for the Township's efforts in keeping the roads open for school bus travel during the recent siege of snow and ice, was received, noted and filed.

A letter from the County Health Board announcing a special meeting Feb, 10 at 7:30 PM regarding Minimum Lot Size requirement in Licking County, was received, noted and filed.

Mr. Hull reported that on Friday Jan. 30, 1976 at approximately 3:10 PM the snow plow and North Fork school bus #11, driven by Carol Heskit, collided in a curve on Twp. Rd. 251. Truck was travelling NE and the bus SW. The highway patrol investigated the accident and no citation was issued. Roads were in an icy condition. Accident was also reported to the Insurance Agency. The Board of Trustees considered the possibility of widening the road (Twp. #251) at the place of the accident.
