The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present: Trustees: James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.

Clerk: John E. Kinney & Road Supt: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the Feb. 2nd meeting were read and approved.

A letter from The LEADS-CETA Manpower Program detailing the Summer Youth Work Program for 1976, was received, noted and filed.

A letter was received from the County Auditor and the County Treasurer notifying Washington Township that application had been made to the State Board of Tax Appeals to extend the time for payment of real estate taxes to May 31st, 1976. This request had been necessitated by failure of the Appraisal Company to furnish the County Auditor's office the re-appraisal information. No objection was filed by the Board of Trustees.

A letter in regard to the "SUNSHINE LAW" dated Feb. 11, 1976 to all Political Subdivisions from the the Licking County Prosecuting Attorney was received. This letter further explained the law and recommended strict compliance of the open meeting sessions.

Some progress had been made on the improvement of Twp. Rd. 251. People from the County Engineer's office had staked the road and proceeded to prepare easements for approval of adjoining land owners.
