The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees: James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.

Clerk: John E. Kinney and Road Supt.: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the March 31st meeting were read and approved.

With reference to the widening of the driveway to the Township plot, the Trustees had met with the representative of the adjacent property owner. After checking the levels of the drainage way it was found that a culvert farther down-stream was hindering the water flow. The Board and the land owner decided to hold on the widening project until more information could be had on lowering the downstream culvert.

The limestone which had been applied on the Township roads was generally considered to be a great improvement over previous applications, due to the holding and lasting qualities of the limestone.
