The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees - James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.
Clerk - John E. Kinney and Road Supt. - Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the April 12th meeting were read and approved.

By mutual agreement of the Board, meeting time was changed from 7:30 PM to 8:00 PM during the daylight savings time period. The clerk was requested to advise the local news media.

Mention was made that there was a bill before the Ohio law-makers which if passed would increase allowable payment to trustees and place Township Trustees on a salary basis. Mr. Torrens expressed dissatisfaction with the salary basis for trustees.

The clerk reported that he had received a letter from the Licking County Veterans Commission requesting information concerning the burial of Veterans in cemeteries under care of the Township. A special visit to the COAD cemetery was made by the clerk and no evidence of veterans burial could be found on markers or from a member of the Coad family, and the Veterans Commission was so advised.
