The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees*James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.
Clerk: John E. Kinney; Road Supt: Myers W. Hull
Others: Robert Orr.

The minutes of the May 10th meeting were read and approved.

A report was received from the Utica Emergency Service covering the period Jan. 1, 1976 thru April 28, 1976 showing that eighteen squad runs had been made in the Township.

Mr. Robert Orr, resident of Washington Township, explained to the Board that ~~xx~~ six head of cattle, which do not belong to him, were on his farm and that, he had notified the person who he believed to be the owner of the cattle and also had notified the County Sheriff's office. He further stated that he had not received any response or contact from the probable owner and asked the trustees whether or not they could have any jurisdiction in helping him to resolve the matter. The Trustees, after much discussion and checking the Township laws, believed that, since the cattle were not on Township public roads or in an uninclosed area, they were not involved in Mr. Orr's problem. However, the trustees agreed to meet with Mr. Orr and an investigator from the office of the County Prosecutor and look over the condition of fences and try to determine whether the cattle passed through the fence or through a gate which may have been open.
