The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees: James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.  
Clerk: John E. Kinney; Road Supt: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the May 24th meeting were read and approved.

The clerk reported that in order to have sufficient funds in the checking account to make payment of bills at this meeting, he had cashed Certificate of Deposit # C670 in amount of \$2130.00 and deposited same in the Township checking account.

Forms had been received from the County Auditor for preparation of the 1977 Budget. The clerk stated that he could have the preliminary entries completed for the June 21st meeting and the Board believed that the Budget could be completed at the June 21st meeting and that a Public Hearing could be held on July 6, 1976.
