The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Trustees-James W. Torrens and Jack T. Londot.
Clerk-John E. Kinney and Road Supt-Myers W. Hull.
Absent: Trustee- George F. Wince.

The minutes of the June 7th meeting were read and approved.
