The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present: Trustees - James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.  
Clerk - John E. Kinney and Road Supt. - Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the July 19th meeting were read and approved.

A fire report from the Fire Prevention Officer was received reporting a fire on July 8th at the Franklin Coad farm/.

Mr. Torrens and Mr. Wince reported that they had been contacted by Mr. Mao Angelletti, a resident landowner of Washington Township, complaining that the fence of the adjoining landowner, Forest Riley, a landowner in Burlington Township, was in such bad condition that his livestock could not be contained.

The location of the line fence is reported to be the same as the boundary line between Washington Township and Burlington Township. Since the fence in need of repair or replacement is believed to be the responsibility of a Burlington Township landowner, the Board decided to consult with the Licking County Prosecutor to determine which Township should handle the problem.
