The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present: Trustees - James W. Torrens, George F. Wince and Jack T. Londot.  
Clerk - John E. Kinney and Road Supt. - Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the August 2nd meeting were read and approved.

The February settlement of Real Property taxes had been received from the County Auditor and the deductions for Workmen's Compensation were more in amount than had been anticipated at the time annual appropriations were made.

In order to cover this amount, Mr. Wince moved that the following transfers be made:

From- Gen. Fund 1A25	to Gen Fund 1A15	86.07
From- Gas Tax Fund 3A10	to Gas Tax Fund 3A3	57.49

Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote resulted as follows:  
Mr. Torrens - Yea; Mr. Wince - Yea; Mr. Londot - Yea.

The president declared the motion passed.

Notice was received from the Office of Revenue Sharing that upon receipt of the completed form "Authorization for Federal Recurring Payments" future payments to the Township would be made by "direct deposit-electronic funds transfer" to the Township Depository. After consideration by the Trustees and the Clerk, it was decided to start this method of payments with the January 1977 payment.
