The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present: Trustees- James W. Torrens and Jack T. Londot.

The minutes of the October 11th meeting were read and approved.

Various information was received from the Office of Revenue Sharing relative to "Public Works Employment Act of 1976, Anti-Recession Title II." Included with this material was a "STATEMENT OF ASSURANCES" form which all local governments must sign and return, even though they may not all participate in the program. This "Statement" assures the Secretary of the Treasury that all regulations pertaining to the program will be complied with by Washington Township, the recipient government.

Mr. Londot moved that the "Statement of Assurances" form be signed by the President of the Board of Trustees and that the clerk forward the same to the Office of Revenue Sharing.
