The Board of Trustees of Washington Township met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present: Trustees - James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.

The minutes of the January 31st meeting were read and approved.

A letter had been received from Neil M. Laughlin, Prosecuting Attorney of Licking County, enclosing a copy of a letter he had received from Attorney Harvey H. Shapiro in which his client Luther Roach complained that the Trustees of Washington Township, in improving Twp Rd. 206, had damaged his property. Trustees Mr. Torrens and Mr. Wince met with Mr. Laughlin on Feb. 14, 1977 and explained to him the details and procedure of work which had been done on Twp. Rd. 206. Mr. Laughlin stated that he would respond to Mr. Shapiro and furnish the Trustees with a copy of his letter. (All correspondence relative to this matter is filed under ( LUTHER ROACH )

Letter was received from the County Auditor and Treasurer that the first half tax collection date was being extended from Feb. 19 to March 31, 1977.
