The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present: Trustees*James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot
Clerk*John E. Kinney; Road Supt-Myers W. Hull
Others:- Evelyn Hull.

The minutes of the February 28th meeting were read and approved.

The clerk reported that earlier in the day Mr. W.J. Wilson Jr. reported to him that a part of his road fence on Cooksey Rd. (TR206) between his lane and the south line had been damaged by snow removal equipment. The Trustees Mr. Torrens and Mr. Wince scheduled to contact Mr. Wilson on Mar. 15th and inspect the fence with him.

A Public Hearing on the proposed use of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds in amount of \$6968.00 for entitlement period eight had been advertised for 8:30 PM this date. No persons appeared at this time. After some discussion of the matter, Mr. Londot moved that a Public Hearing be advertised on the budgeting of these funds be set for March 28, 1977 in the Township office at 8:00 PM and that the clerk place a notice in the local newspaper. Mr. Wince seconded the motion and the vote was as follows:

Mr. Torrens-Yea; Mr. Wince-Yea; Mr. Londot-Yea. Motion passed.

Evelyn Hull appeared before the Board stating that she represented an organization of non-certified school employees and asked if it would be possible for the group to hold meetings in the Township office. The opinion of the Board was that it may not be appropriate to allow this and suggested some other locations in the village.
