The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

The minutes of the March 14th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Lacey was recognized and he explained to the Board that he had purchased 20 acres of land on the east side of TR 208 and questioned the Board as ~~plan~~ to the plans for upgrading this road so that he would have better ~~access~~ access to his property. He was informed that the County Engineer was to survey this road and after this was completed the Township could proceed with improving the condition of the road.

A Public Hearing of the Budgeting of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds of entitlement period 8 had been advertised for 8:00 PM this date. No persons appeared at this hearing.

These funds, ~~for~~ for the period Jan. 1, 1977 to Sept. 30, 1977 are in the amount of \$6968.00 and should be received by the Township in near equal amounts on or about April 7, July 7 and Oct. 7, 1977.

Mr. Wince moved that these funds be budgeted for road improvement and that the amount is included in the appropriation of Jan. 17, 1977 in the Capital Improvement Fund of Federal Revenue Sharing.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote was as follows:
