The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

The minutes of the May 9th meeting were read and approved.

Notice was received from State of Ohio Department of Liquor Control advising that SECTION 4303.271 O.R.C. as amended Aug. 6, 1977 gives the legislative authority of a political subdivision the right to object to the issuance of a RENEWAL of a liquor permit within 30 days prior to expiration date.

Mr. Wince was appointed to have the COAD cemetery mowed and cleaned prior to May 30th.

Roadway condition of the Township highways was discussed by the Board. It was generally agreed that: the application of limestone and salt brine, and proper use of grader, the roads were in very good condition.


Mr. Wince moved that the preceeding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.

Mr. Torrens-Yea; Mr. Wince-Yea; Mr. Londot- Yea.


The president declabed the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository or in process of collection to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.


