The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were-Trustees: James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot.
Clerk: John E. Kinney and Road Supt: Myers W. Hull.

The minutes of the May 23rd meeting were read and approved.

The fire protection contract with the Utica Volunteer Fire Dept. is due to expire on June 30, 1977 and a new contract was received from the Department for the period beginning June 30, 1977 for a three year period ending June 30, 1980 at a total cost of \$4500.00 payable in installments of \$750.00 each six months in advance. Mr. Wince moved that this contract be accepted and that the first payment be made at the next meeting on June 20, 1977 and each six months thereafter during the life of the contract.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote was as follows:
Mr. Torrens-Yea; Mr. Wince-Yea; Mr. Londot-Yea. Motion approved.

Spraying of weeds along Township roads was considered by the Board. The question of whether to buy a sprayer and material to do the job or to hire an outside contractor was undecided at this time.
