The Washington Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting business of the Township.

Present for the meeting were Trustees: George F. Wince, Jack T. Londot and Myers W. Hull, Clerk Neil D. Reeder and Road Supt. Jerry L. Hull.

The minutes of the meeting of January 1, 1984 were read and approved.

Resolution hiring the Rad Superintendant and establishing rates of pay for employees:

Mr. Londot moved that Jerry L. Hull be hired as Road Supt. for the year 1984 and that his rate of pay be Eight Dollars per hour and that he be paid at the rate of time and one half for overtime above forty hour in any calender week. That he be allowed vacation pay of (\$640.00) Six Hundred and Forty Dollars which is 80 hours at regular rate of pay. That other employees be paid at the rate of (\$6.00) Six Dollars per hour. The above rate to begin January 1, 1984. Mr. Hull seconded the motion. Vote: Wince, Yea., Londot, Yea, Mr. Hull, yea.

RESOLUTION ALLOWING EXPENSES AND AUTHORITY AND RETAINING ZONING INSPECTOR:

Item: 1.

That the necessary expenses incurred by Township Officials while in attendance at National, State and County Associations meeting and in the performance of Official business be allowed at cost and that mileage be allowed at twenty two cents per mile, garage and telephone expenses be allowed at cost.

Item: 2

That each Trustee be given authority to take care of any emergency as deemed necessary and that each Trustee be allowed to instruct the Road Supt. in handling emergencies.

Item: 3

That the Clerk be allowed to purchase ordinary and necessary office supplies as needed.


Item: 4




