The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting business of the Township.

Mr. Torrens reported that he had spoke with Thomas Frederick in regards to the zoning agreement. It would be completed soon and forwarded to the Trustees.

Mr. Hull reported that the dump truck is at Yoakums for repair. He also reported the base and tower for the radio unit has been completed but the mobil units must be installed.

Jerry Hull, Road Supt., reported that several pads need patching or replaced. The pad in front of the Willis property on Peat Moss Rd. was reported to be almost gone. Cold mix could be used due to the weather.

Mr. Hull also reported that he had received several calls regarding the proposed closing of the portion of Wilson Rd. Even though there appears to be some public resentment to the closing, the Trustees unanimously feel the question is entirely economic. Financially the Township cannot afford to maintain the portion of the road in question. There will be another viewing of the road on Nov. 24, 1986 and the hearing will be held by the County Commissioners on Dec. 8, 1986. Mr. Wince and Mr. Hull will attend a Commissioners meeting prior to the next Township meeting.

Meeting adjourned on motion of Mr. Wince, seconded by Mr. Hull.
