Clayton King was present at the meeting to address the Board regarding salt water application. Mr. King is a representative from Ray Penick Salt Water. Mr. Penick has raised the price of salt water 1/2 cent. The new application prices are 5¢/gal if applied to roads, 2¢/ gal if picked up. Mr. King advised the Board that many Township's are giving up chip and seal for salt water because of the expense.

The Board also announced that the bridge on Hunt Rd. collapsed during the recent heavy snow fall when a large vehicle was plowing snow. The County Engineer's office will be in charge of replacement. The bridge was scheduled for replacement in the near future anyhow.

Mr. Torrens moved that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by Mr. Wince. Vote unanimous.
