
The minutes of the meeting held April 13, 1987 were read and approved.

It was also reported that a squabble has arisen between Earl Baker and Newton Township resident Wilbur Bullock. It was reported that Mr. Bullock had plowed a portion of Township Road #203.


Mr. Torrens reported he had talked to the Shelly Co. in regards to a bid to treat the Township roads. He reported that 8000gal. of liquid would run approximately \$7040.00 and gravel approximately 2600.00. That would average approximately .64/ foot.

Clayton King again attended the meeting and brought with him a bid for salt water application. A copy of this will be attached to the minutes.


It was reported the Willis property is still having ditch problems.

Mr. Wince moved that the meeting be adjourned with Mr. Torrens seconding the motion. Motion carried, meeting adjourned.
